Pray

Talk

In today's Gospel reading Jesus gives his famous Sermon on the Mount. Beatitudes are eight blessings recounted by Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus teaches us that if we live according to the Beatitudes we will live a happy Christian life. The Beatitudes fulfil God's promises made to Abraham and his descendants and describe the rewards that will be ours as loyal followers of Jesus.

Who in your life is a model of Beatitudes? Share with each other giving examples of the Beatitudes in action.

HAPPY OR BLESSED?

The Hebrew word used by Jesus at the very start of today's Gospel is translated as "happy or "blessed". Some translations use "happy", others use "blessed". So which word do we use? I like to use the word "blessed".

You can be happy with a Mars bar or when your team wins. But to be blessed is very different. A blessing comes from God. In what way can we be blessed by God? What strikes us from this Gospel is that God's ways of blessing us are very different to what we might choose. To be poor? I am blessed when I have nothing else to rely on except God. The less of me, the more of God. Mourning? When you have lost what is dear to you, then you can be open to the consolation of Jesus.

Worried about your image? God can help me to be content with who I am. Worried about the lack of meaning in life? I am blessed when I get my inside world right - my heart and mind. Then I am right with God and others and myself. Finding it difficult to get on with others? God will help you to cooperate without fighting, to be merciful and a maker of peace. Looking at others in ways I should not? God will help us discover beauty in all things, even in what does not seem beautiful. Finding it tough to love others even if they are being mean or awful to you? God will bless you with patience and help you forgive.

When we live our lives like this we will truly make the world a better place because we are inviting Jesus to work in us. The Beatitudes are a portrait of Jesus Christ in words. When we live the Beatitudes we become more like him.


