Sunday Mass Readings

Hear

As you watch the video with your children, pay attention to how connect the Psalm to their relationship with Jesus.

Listen: Psalm 23 for Adults

As you listen to this song what feelings resonate with you? How do the words of the song relate with your relationship with God?

Talk

In the first reading and the psalm we are reminded that our God is not a distant God. He is always with us in good times and in challenging times too.

- What blessings have you received from God this past week?
- What are some of the challenges you are facing in school or at work at the moment?
- How can you show the love of Jesus to others this coming week?
- How can you invite Jesus to be the King of your heart and of your home?

Family Challenge!

CHRIST, THE UNIVERSAL KING

When we think of a king what picture comes to mind? Maybe you think of castles or palaces, with courtiers and guards, and perhaps lavish feasts and banquets, all far removed from the lives of ordinary people. But with today's feast, of Christ the Universal King, the opposite is true. We have a divine, eternal king who is not distant or far removed from us.

Our Heavenly King has come to us and he unites us intimately with himself through the Sacraments, through his living Word in the Scriptures, and especially through the Eucharist, his Body and Blood, our food for eternal life. Jesus has come as our King to bring us into communion with the Blessed Trinity in the deepest possible way.

In today's Gospel Jesus speaks about the final judgement on the last day. The people are judged according to how they have lived, and in particular, how they have loved. In other words, what quality of love is present in my life? How am I loving God? How am I loving others? How is that love made manifest, and how have I received or accepted love? Do I accept and believe that I am a beloved child of God, made in his image and likeness?

Not only is Christ our King, but we, through our Baptism, are anointed with royal status. We are his brothers and sisters, members of God's royal family. That's not just a pious platitude or wishful thinking. It's really true! Baptism consecrates us as priests, prophets and kings. Reflect on that fact this week. You and I are children of the true King of Kings and heirs to the Kingdom of Heaven.


Family Prayer
