

1.4C Guidance on Maintaining Adequate Supervision Ratios

In planning a trip or activity, it is critically important to consider how many adults are needed to supervise children in a safe manner.

At a minimum, two adults are required for each activity. In addition, the minimum following ratios should be applied. These ratios may need to be reviewed depending on whether the children/young people have specific needs or requirements and on the duration of the activity.

Within each group the ratio of adults to children is determined by the age of the children involved.

- 0-1 year: one member of staff to *three* children
- 1-2 years: one member of staff to *five* children
- 2-3 years: one member of staff to *six* children
- 3-6 years: one member of staff to *eight* children
- 7-12 years: one member of staff to *eight* children
- 13-18 years: one member of staff to *ten* children

If it is an overnight activity, additional staff should be considered. If the group is mixed, a gender balance should be maintained.
