### 1.4C Guidance on Maintaining Adequate Supervision Ratios

In planning a trip or activity, it is critically important to consider how many adults are needed to supervise children in a safe manner.

At a minimum, two adults are required for each activity. In addition, the minimum following ratios should be applied. These ratios may need to be reviewed depending on whether the children/young people have specific needs or requirements and on the duration of the activity.

## Within each group the ratio of adults to children is determined by the age of the children involved.

- 0-1 year: one member of staff to three children
- 1-2 years: one member of staff to five children
- 2-3 years: one member of staff to six children
- 3-6 years: one member of staff to eight children
- 7-12 years: one member of staff to eight children
- 13-18 years: one member of staff to ten children

If it is an overnight activity, additional staff should be considered. If the group is mixed, a gender balance should be maintained.
