Advent symbol: THE JESSE TREE



The Jesse Tree is a way of preparing for Advent by discovering more about Salvation History through the stories of Jesus's family tree. Each day of Advent, read a Bible story or extract about one of Jesus' ancestors, and hang the appropriate symbol / ornament on your Jesse Tree, which can be something as simple as a branch. As the number of decorations increase, you'll see the story of salvation unfold: how God prepared for Jesus to be born through many generations.



Advent symbol: THE JESSE TREE



Isaiah 11:1:

"A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse,
and a branch shall grow out of his roots."

Jesse was the father of David, who became Israel's greatest king. Jesus is descended from the line of David, the promised "branch" in the line of Jesse and David.
