WHAT IS THE ROLE OF A DIOCESAN FAITH REPRESENTATIVE?

- Support clergy and post-primary school teachers in enabling young people to form a relationship with God
- Link between parish, school, and home, under the guidance of the Diocese
- Linked to the Pope John Paul II Award, where possible
- Enable / support key Diocesan Youth & Young Adult Ministry Projects and Events
- Circulate information regarding Youth & Young Adult Events / Pilgrimages etc.
- Attend relevant Diocesan Faith Formation Conferences and workshops
- Be a part of the ongoing development of youth & young adult ministry within the diocese, particularly through their feedback / experience on the ground
- Supported, trained and resourced by the Diocese and parish
- Every parish situation is different: collaborative consultation with parish priest is essential
- Encouraged to network with neighbouring parishes

- Publicising the commissioning of the selected Diocesan Faith Representatives.

TRAINING, RESOURCING AND SUPPORTING FAITH REPRESENTATIVES

- TRAINING: Diocesan Safeguarding Training, Running Alpha Youth, Role of Pope John Paul II Award Leader, Small group facilitation, Mentoring, Walking with Generation Z & Generation A...
- RESOURCING: provided by both the parish and the Youth & Young Adult Ministry Officer, members of the Ascend Strategic Task Force / other experienced facilitators
- Support: In-person and zoom meetings, annual Faith-based retreat / conference, Annual Ascend newsletter, Weekly "To the Heights" newsletter & Ascend resource, one-to-one mentoring, website / email support. The local Parish Priest / Curate will provide secondary support to the Diocesan Faith Representative and will involve them in relevant parish committees e.g. pastoral committee / parish leadership team.
