STATIONS OF THE CROSS – LENT 2022



1st Station - Jesus is condemned to death

Lord, by your cross and resurrection, you have set us free. You are the saviour of the world.

Lord, give me the courage to always do what I know in my heart to be right and just, even if it makes me feel unpopular with those around me. I am sometimes very quick to condemn others, while not thinking about their welfare or how my actions will affect them. Forgive me Lord.

3rd Station – Jesus falls for the first time

I need to accept willingly your plan for me. Grant me Lord, the gift of perseverance to start again.

4th Station - Jesus meets his blessed mother

Lord, you know a mother's sorrow. You saw her deep in grief on your last journey. Help all parents who are upset with worry and anguish on behalf of their children. Teach me Lord to show true compassion to others.

5th Station – Simon helps Jesus to carry his cross

Lord, help me to always show good example, and to support those who need help in these difficult times. May I always be willing to help carry the crosses of others.

6th Station – Veronica wipes the face of Jesus

8th Station - The Women of Jerusalem mourn for Jesus

Lord, by your cross and resurrection, you have set us free. You are the saviour of the world.

Lord, as you struggled on your final journey, you found time to give comfort to the weeping women of Jerusalem. Help me to realise that I too am vulnerable at times and I need the help of others. May I always be meek and humble of heart.

9th Station – Jesus falls a third time

11th Station - Jesus is nailed to the cross

Lord, you had to endure such pain in your last hours on earth, but you still remembered me as you placed me into the care of your Mother. Help me Lord, to be like your Mother with my own family – full of love, care and compassion.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end, Amen.

12th Station – Jesus dies on the cross

Lord, by your cross and resurrection, you have set us free. You are the saviour of the world.

Lord, compassion was shown at the foot of your cross by those who loved you and wept at your suffering and death. You gave them great capacity for love. Help me Lord, to show love again and not let your death be in vain.

13th Station – Jesus is taken down from the cross

Lord, by your cross and resurrection, you have set us free. You are the saviour of the world.

Lord, after your death, you were taken down from the cross and placed into the arms of your Mother. I remember all those who have died this past year. May they be folded into the warm embrace of your mother. May I also be a source of comfort to others, as you are to all who love you.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end, Amen.

14th Station – Jesus is laid in the tomb

Lord, by your cross and resurrection, you have set us free. You are the saviour of the world.

Jesus, you left this world in pain and sorrow and were badly treated on your way. On the third day you rose again and overcame the power of death and restored life. Give me this hope in my life – that despite all the difficulties I may have to endure, your love will see me home and into the arms of my loving Father in heaven.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end, Amen.

He is risen from the dead and he is Lord.
Every knee shall bow, every tongue confess,
