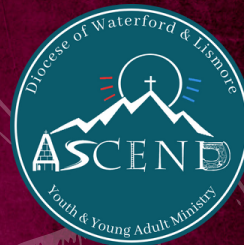

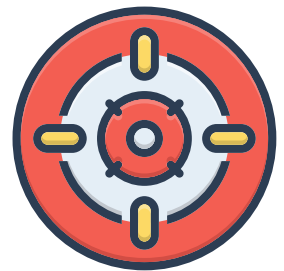
Would you rather?
