

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

HOW WOULD YOU EXPLAIN THAT MASS ISN'T ABOUT WHAT WE GET OUT OF IT, BUT RATHER WHAT WE GIVE TO GOD?



SET ASIDE A FEW MINUTES TO WATCH THE SHORT FILM: "THE VEIL REMOVED". BEFORE YOU WATCH, ASK THE LORD TO OPEN YOUR HEART TO THE MYSTERIES HE WANTS TO REVEAL TO YOU ABOUT THE HEART OF WORSHIP, THE SACRIFICE OF THE MASS AND TO LET THIS EXPERIENCE HELP YOU TO UNDERSTAND THE MASS IN A DEEPER WAY.
