RECOGNISING JESUS

Think about your own life: have you had a moment or a season of encounter with God? It doesn't have to be super dramatic: it can be ordinary, natural, calm - maybe it's only when you look back at your life you can actually see what was happening. Are there any God-moments in your life so far? Don't dismiss anything because you think it's too small!





READ: LUKE 2

Have you ever met someone famous? Maybe you knew you were going to meet them and you were so excited! You knew all about them, you were their No. 1 fan! Maybe you just saw them in the distance and that was enough. Simeon and Anna in this Gospel passage from Luke waited their entire lives to encounter the Messiah - the long prophesied one who would save their nation and they instantly recognised Him as a tiny baby. Can you imagine the amount of trust and faith in God they had to recognise His presence in a tiny little baby boy, unable to speak yet, so totally dependent on his parents for everything? Do we recognise Jesus and His presence in our lives? Have we meet Him, really and truly encountered Him in a personal way that changed our lives? It might not have been a dramatic event, maybe just gradual over time, but to really be a Christian involves a personal encounter with the One who created us, knows us and loves us infinitely. That changes everything. Maybe you're not sure if you've met Jesus personally, and that's ok! The good news is you have so many more opportunities - every moment of every day in fact! And all you have to do is ask Him to reveal Himself to you - make a simple and honest prayer with the heart. Then let Him introduce Himself to you and become part of your life.



Take some time this week to reflect honestly on your relationship with Jesus:

- IT MIGHT BE REALLY STRONG, THE MOST IMPORTANT THING IN YOUR LIFE!
- IT MIGHT BE A LITTLE ROCKY: YOU KNOW HE'S IMPORTANT BUT IT'S HARD TO STAY
 FOCUSSED ON THAT.
- YOU MIGHT FEEL LIKE YOU REALLY DON'T KNOW HIM AT ALL, OR MAYBE YOU THINK IT'S NOT EVEN POSSIBLE TO HAVE A RELATIONSHIP WITH HIM.
