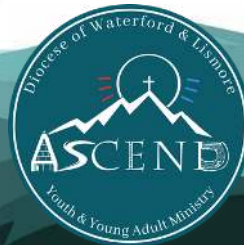

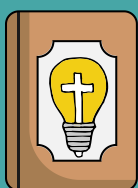

We always seem to want to get ahead of ourselves. "I'll be happy when....", on and on, never actually reaching that state of happiness we keep promising ourselves. It's hard for us to stop and appreciate the moment we're in, the gifts we're receiving right now, the person we can become through the situations we find ourselves in.

Jesus knows that we can't handle everything in one moment. That's why He sent the Holy Spirit to the Apostles too. He knew there was only so much they could grasp while He was still with them, but the Holy Spirit would be their constant Teacher and Guide, their Advocate and He would reveal whatever they needed to know at the most appropriate time for them.

Jesus asks us to trust Him in the same way: to trust that His plan for us includes His perfect timing also. He wants us to learn and grow in the present moment and then we'll be ready for the next challenge, the next set of graces, the next piece of the puzzle. He doesn't want us to be anxious or afraid: He knows how much we can handle at any given moment. He wants us to be at peace. He wants us to love Him. Trusting in Jesus means trusting in His timing. It also means opening our hearts and our ears to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

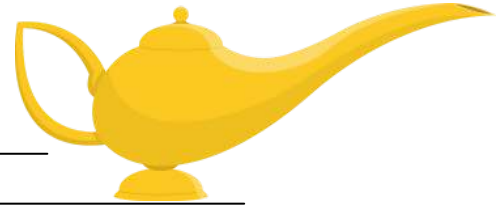


LIVING IN THE PRESENT

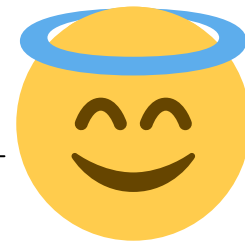
