


"PILGRIMS OF HOPE" PARISH PROJECT



2025 is a Jubilee Year: We are called to be Pilgrims of Hope. Being a pilgrim is different to being a tourist. Tourists arrive at a destination to capture memories; pilgrims go on journey to change, or out of a desire for change.

PROJECT:

THINK OF YOUR PARISH AS A PLACE OF PILGRIMAGE

AND ADDRESSING THE TOPICS OVERLEAF.

PRODUCE A PROJECT TO SHOW YOUR FINDINGS.



Your guiding question is:

"If I was a pilgrim journeying to my parish, what could I see, what could I do, what could I participate in? How can my faith be impacted by my parish?"



FORMAT CHOICES:



TYPED ESSAY (Minimum 1200 words)



Recording of 3 - 4 minutes (must be clearly audible).



Brochure (with images): 4 x A4 pages (images etc can be glued on if necessary)



A2 size poster (images etc can be glued on if necessary)



2 - 4 minutes in length.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Safeguarding and GDPR:
 - Please ask permission of parish priest to to take photos and videos in the parish for this project.
 - You must have written consent from people if taking / using photos / audio interview extracts / video footage of them. If the subject is U18 you must have joint written consent both from them and their parent / guardian. Please follow school / parish safeguarding procedures for this.
- When arranging to interview parish priest / sacristan it is best to do this in groups / pairs to avoid them having to repeat the interviews!
- You may wish to share your project with or display your project in your local parish consult your parish priest about this first. It is advisable to show the project first to him.

THEMES / TOPICS TO LOOK AT IN YOUR PROJECT:

MY LOCAL CHURCH:

- Name of your local Church
- When was it built?
- What statues are there?
- Is there stained glass? What is represented?
- Is there a grotto (indoors or outdoors)?
- Are there particular shrines?
- Is there a Holy Well in your area?
- Are there special Catholic feast days particular to your parish?
- Does your parish have a choir and or / cantor?
- What possibility is there for youth involvement?
- Are there family Masses or children's liturgies?
- Are there Graveyard Masses?
- Are there special feast days?



- Mass times
- Confession times
- Lighting candles
- Rosary devotions?
- Prayer groups?
- Adoration?
