SOME IDEAS FOR YOUR ACTIVITIES!

- (O) means in your own time, (S) means during school hours.
- Maximum of 50% of parish or social hours can come from activities during school time (including parish work done <u>during</u> the school day).
- Each activity just counts as one hour per week. If a weekly event is less than an hour, mark it as .5 hours. If it is 1-4 hours, it is still recorded as 1 hour. (e.g. litter picking for 3 classes in one week is recorded as one hour)
- If it is more than 5 hours continuously in one activity, look at Top Up section.
