- Christmas is a Season of Joy in the midst of uncertainty.






ARE THE "JOYFUL MYSTERIES" REALLY JOYFUL???

- What kind of things could the Angel have told Mary to take away some of her uncertainty? (List 2 things Fr Mike mentions)




- "All is calm, all is bright...." Was it really? What kind of uncertainty did Mary and Joseph face in Bethlehem?


